# Keynote: Carolyn Jones

Photographic Ethnographer, Director, Producer

Carolyn Jones creates projects that point our attention towards issues of global concern. Jones has spent the past five years interviewing more than 150 nurses from every corner of the US in an effort to better understand the role of nurses in this country's healthcare system. She published the critically-acclaimed book The American Nurse: Photographs and Interviews and directed and executive-produced the follow-up documentary film, The American Nurse: Healing America, which was released in theaters nationwide and was an official selection of the 2015 American Film Showcase. Defining Hope, Jones's most recent venture, follows a number of people as they grapple with medical and moral questions about wellness, sickness, dying and living. The film won "Best Premiere, Documentary Feature" at the Heartland Film Festival.
