- Free parking is available

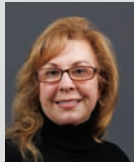

TEMPLE UNIVERSITY NAME CHANGE PROJECT

Have a team of law students support you each step of the way through the legal name change process. Note: One in-person meeting is usually required.

Process

1. Email templelawnamechangeproject@gmail.com with your request.
2. You will receive an auto-response that lets you know about the service and will direct you to fill out the intake form.
3. Expect to meet with your assigned law students at least once to review the petition they've drafted for you.
