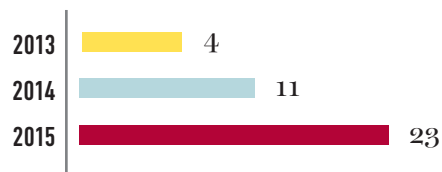
#### ANNUAL REVENUES (IN MILLIONS)
